Southern Stars Performing Company 2026 Audition Information Package

The Southern Stars Performing Company is a group of performers consisting of dance, drama, vocal, choir and instrumental students who are selected through an audition process for Southern Stars.

All NSW Public School students in Years 2 – 12 are eligible to apply.

What to consider before applying:

- Performers from the Company can be asked to perform at special Departmental and community events, but their focus each year is Southern Stars.
- Rehearsals are usually outside school hours and some scheduled school days prior to events.
- Southern Stars, Dance Festival, Drama Festival and Pulse Alive require a commitment over several school days.
- Southern Stars 2026 will be held 25 29 August 2026 at WIN Entertainment Centre,
 Wollongong
- There will be a compulsory workshop held over several days during the July School Holidays for all groups proposed dates can be found further on in this document.
- It is essential that all members fully support their school CAPA programs to the best of their ability

Financial Commitments:

- An application fee of \$35.00 per student per company application is payable to cover the costs associated with the running of the Southern Stars Performing Company auditions. eg. If a student wishes to audition for more than 1 company ie. Dance and drama then a SEPARATE application form and application fee for each is required for each company. <u>Link to Trybooking</u> for payment.
- An annual company fee of \$350 is payable upon a student's acceptance into the company. A limited number of fee waivers are available through the scholarship program for students who may require financial assistance. All students are strongly encouraged to audition, and applications from all interested candidates are welcome.
- Additional costs will be incurred by all performers for costumes (to be advised by the design team), personal travel & meals etc.
- Financial hardship scholarship. Students may be able to apply for a financial hardship scholarship to cover the cost of the company fee. The student would need to complete the scholarship application once they have been successful.
- Students should follow all school procedures for applying for external companies before completing the application form. All Principals will be emailed a list of students applying to audition, once applications are closed.

Audition Regulations:

All auditions are closed to parents, other students and members of the public. Only the auditioning student and their accompanist (where applicable) should enter the audition room.

- Complete the online application here by 27 February 2026
- Students DO NOT need to prepare an audition piece. They will attend a workshop presented by a professional choreographer/teacher for their audition.
- Please ensure your student is wearing appropriate dance attire dance shoes are optional.
- Bring snacks and water

- Please be aware that there will also be compulsory rehearsals during July school holidays that all students must attend

Vocal Company Auditions

General Information:

- The Vocal Company consists of three components Featured Artists, Backing Vocalists and Featured Vocal Ensemble.
- The Vocal Company consists of vocalists from Year 2 to Year 12 who will assume backing vocal, small ensemble and/or soloist roles in performing the vast repertoire of songs in this year's production of Southern Stars 2026.
- The Featured Vocal Ensemble are an ensemble of approximately 30 vocalists from Years 5 12 who form an advanced choral group singing in two, three and four-part harmony to support the Featured Artists and Backing Vocalists and to showcase as a solo ensemble, both at Southern Stars and other regional activities.
- We also encourage students of all vocal styles, including beatboxing, rap and other vocal talents to audition.
- Please keep in mind that the show you are auditioning for is large scale, high energy and very electric with a wide audience demographic. All too often students perform pieces of music that aren't appropriate for Southern Stars or don't give us enough scope to be able to hear your singing in a musical style that will ultimately be chosen for the show. When choosing your songs, do your research. Look at past performances to see what style of songs have been performed and use this information to inform your choices. Most of all keep your song choices age-appropriate, e.g. A teenager singing "My Heart Will Go On" or "She Used to Be Mine" is not considered an appropriate song choice for this show.

What are the live audition requirements?

- Auditionees need to prepare two songs one of their own choosing and one from a list of repertoire provided by the panel. These will be presented in the round 1 live auditions.
- No more than 1 min and 30 secs
- The list of repertoire songs will be sent out to all students after applications close.
- Students will need to submit their backing track and headshot, prior to their audition. Form link will be emailed closer to the audition date.

Audition Process:

- An application fee of \$35.00 per student per company application is payable to cover the costs associated with the running of the Southern Stars Performing Company auditions. eg. If a student wishes to audition for more than 1 company ie. Dance and drama then a SEPARATE application form and application fee for each is required for each company. <u>Link to Trybooking</u> for payment.

Orchestra Auditions

Requirements

Instruments Required

- Strings Violin, Cello, Viola, Double Bass
- Woodwind Flute, Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Alto Sax, Tenor Sax, Baritone Sax
- Brass French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba
- Percussion Timpani, Tuned Percussion, Untuned Percussion
- Rhythm Section Drum Kit, Piano, Synthesiser, Guitar, Bass Guitar
- Students may nominate multiple instruments, including instruments not listed above, but should clearly identify their first preference from this list.
- All performers will be expected to read standard music notation.

Audition Process:

- An application fee of \$35.00 per student per company application is payable to cover the costs associated with the running of the Southern Stars Performing Company auditions. eg. If a student wishes to audition for more than 1 company ie. Dance and drama then a SEPARATE application form and application fee for each is required for each company. <u>Link to Trybooking</u> for payment.
- Complete the online application here by 27 February 2026
- Attach a link to a video audition of a piece of free choice, designed to demonstrate the
 performer's ability and range of style, 2 minutes maximum. The live video audition
 should demonstrate a prepared performance; it need not be from the start of the
 selected piece. For how to upload to YouTube or google drive, refer to the information
 on the last page of this document.
- Students who wish to audition for a place as a featured instrumentalist ONLY, still need to complete the audition process. During the audition they can stipulate that they do not want to be a part of the orchestra, only as a featured musician.

Drama Company Auditions

Audition Process:

- An application fee of \$35.00 per student per company application is payable to cover the costs associated with the running of the Southern Stars Performing Company auditions. eg. If a student wishes to audition for more than 1 company ie. Dance and drama then a SEPARATE application form and application fee for each is required for each company. <u>Link to Trybooking</u> for payment.
- Complete the online application here by 27 February 2026
- Students must deliver an individual monologue of 1-2 minutes showcasing their range of dramatic abilities during their live audition.
- All students are encouraged to wear rehearsal blacks to the audition

Rehearsals

- Most rehearsals will be outside school time on weekends and after school.
- There will also be additional school day rehearsals leading up to performances for the combined mass drama item
- Please be aware that there will also be compulsory rehearsals during the July school holidays. Rehearsal dates and times will be made available following the audition process.

Uploading your audition to YouTube or Google Drive

Orchestra auditions only. Dance, drama and vocal auditions are live auditions.

Option 1 – Upload via YouTube

- 1. Visit <u>www.youtube.com</u> and sign in to your account (or create one if you don't have one)
- 2. Click Create → Upload video and follow the on-screen instructions to upload your audition.
- 3. Once uploaded, go to Visibility settings and select Unlisted (this means only people with the link can view your video)
- 4. Save your changes
- 5. Copy the video link (URL) and paste it into the relevant section of your online application form.

If your video is blocked due to copyright (for example, because of a backing track), please use option 2 instead.

Option 2 - Upload via Google Drive

- 1. Visit drive.google.com and sign in with your Google account.
- 2. Click + New → File upload and select your audition video file.
- 3. Once uploaded, right-click the file and choose Share.
- 4. In the sharing settings, click General access → Anyone with the link, then change the access to viewer.
- 5. Copy the shareable link and paste it into the relevant section of your online application form.

This option works well if YouTube blocks your video or if you prefer not to upload to YouTube.
