

## Southern Stars Performing Company 2023 Audition Information Package

**The Southern Stars Performing Company** is a group of performers consisting of dance, drama, vocal, choir and instrumental students who are selected through an audition process for Southern Stars.

All NSW Public School students in Years 2 – 12 are eligible to apply (see table under general information for more specific company requirements).

### What to consider before applying:

- Performers from the Company can be asked to perform at special Departmental and community events, but their main focus each year is Southern Stars.
- Rehearsals are usually outside school hours and some scheduled school days prior to events.
- Southern Stars, Dance Festival, Drama Festival, Pulse Alive and Schools Spectacular require a commitment over a number of school days.
- Southern Stars 2023 will be held 21 - 26 August 2023 at WIN Entertainment Centre.
- There will be a compulsory workshop held over a number of days during the July School Holidays for all groups – proposed dates can be found further on in this document.

### Financial Commitments:

- An application fee of \$30.00 per student per company application is payable to cover the costs associated with the running of the Southern Stars Performing Company auditions. eg. If a student wishes to audition for more than 1 company ie. Dance and drama then 2 x \$30.00 application fees need to be paid. <https://www.trybooking.com/BVXFB>
- Annual company fee of \$300 payable upon acceptance in to the company
- A compulsory Performing Company uniform polo shirt worn at all rehearsals and events will need to be purchased at an additional cost of \$35.
- Optional Performing Company uniform – Jacket \$70, Backpack \$35,
- Additional costs will be incurred by all performers for costumes (to be advised by the design team), personal travel & meals etc.
- Students should follow all school procedures for applying for external companies before completing the application form. All Principals will be emailed a list of students applying to audition, once applications are closed. If for any reason your Principal does not want you to audition, they will address this with you personally.

### Audition Regulations:

All auditions are closed to parents, other students and members of the public. Only the auditioning student and their accompanist (where applicable) should enter the audition room.

### Parent Consent:

By your child attending the audition you are providing consent as per the statement below:

I acknowledge that this event/activity is required to be held in accordance with current NSW Health COVID-19 Public Health Orders and the NSW Department of Education policies and procedures. I acknowledge and accept that there is a risk that my child may be exposed to COVID-19 whilst attending and participating at this event. I confirm that my child will not attend if displaying any symptoms of illness, and/or if directed to isolate under public health orders.

- Students **DO NOT** need to prepare any audition pieces. They will attend a workshop presented by a professional choreographer/teacher as the audition.
- Please ensure students are wearing appropriate dance attire - dance shoes are optional
- Bring snacks and water

- Please be aware that there will also be compulsory rehearsals during July school holidays that all students must attend

# Vocal Company Auditions

## General Information:

- The Vocal Company consists of three components – Featured Artists, Backing Vocalists and Featured Vocal Ensemble.
- The Vocal Company consists of vocalists from Year 2 to Year 12 who will assume backing vocal, small ensemble and/or soloist roles in performing the vast repertoire of songs in this year's production of Southern Stars 2023
- The Featured Vocal Ensemble are an ensemble of approximately 30 vocalists from Years 5 – 12 who form an advanced choral group singing in two, three and four-part harmony to support the Featured Artists and Backing Vocalists and to showcase as a solo ensemble, both at Southern Stars and other regional activities.
- We also encourage students of all vocal styles, including beat-boxing, rap and other vocal talents to audition.
- Please keep in mind that the show you are auditioning for is large scale, high energy and very electric with a wide audience demographic. All too often students perform pieces of music that aren't appropriate for Southern Stars or don't give us enough scope to be able to hear your singing in a musical style that will ultimately be chosen for the show. When choosing your songs, do your research. Look at past performances to see what style of songs have been performed and use this information to inform your choices. Most of all keep your song choices age-appropriate, e.g. A teenager singing "My Heart Will Go On" or "She Used to Be Mine" is not considered an appropriate song choice for this particular show.

## Audition Process:

- Payment of the \$30 Application Fee **MUST** be paid before completing the Audition Application form. Applications will not be accepted until you can provide the Booking ID (found on your receipt). <https://www.trybooking.com/BVXFB>
- Complete the online application [2023 Southern Stars Performing Company Application](#) by **9 February 2023**
- Upload a video audition of 1:30 minutes maximum demonstrating the student's vocal and performance skills, to the application form.
- Successful students will be emailed with further directions for inclusion in the vocal company – including featured artist round 2 audition, backing vocalist auditions and featured vocal ensemble auditions.

- A draft list of rehearsals is below. Students must be able to commit to all of these dates. (Year 12 students' rehearsal schedules will be adapted to suit each successful candidate with as minimal disruption to HSC commitments as possible. This will be done in consultation with the student, parent and school principal)

# Orchestra Auditions

## Requirements

### Instruments Required

- Strings - *Violin, Cello, Double Bass*
- Woodwind - *Flute, Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Alto Sax, Tenor Sax, Baritone Sax*
- Brass - *French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba*
- Percussion - *Timpani, Tuned Percussion, Untuned Percussion*
- Rhythm Section - *Drum Kit, Piano, Synthesiser, Guitar, Bass Guitar*
- Students may nominate multiple instruments, including instruments not listed above, but should clearly identify their first preference from this list.
- All performers will be expected to read standard music notation.
- Performance attire will be required to be supplied by company member

### Audition Process:

- Payment of the \$30 Application Fee MUST be paid before completing the Audition Application form. Applications will not be accepted until you can provide the Booking ID (found on your receipt). <https://www.trybooking.com/BVXFB>
- Complete the online application [2023 Southern Stars Performing Company Application](#) by **9 February 2023**
- Attach a link to a video audition of a piece of free choice, designed to demonstrate the performer's ability and range of style, 2 minutes maximum. The video audition should demonstrate a prepared performance, it need not be from the start of the selected piece.
- All students from Round 1 will receive confirmation of the outcome of their audition.

# Drama Company Auditions

## Audition Process:

- Payment of the \$30 Application Fee **MUST** be paid before completing the Audition Application form. Applications will not be accepted until you can provide the Booking ID (found on your receipt). <https://www.trybooking.com/BVXFB>
- Complete the online application [2023 Southern Stars Performing Company Application](#) by **9 February 2023**
- Students must present an individual monologue, of 1-2 minutes. This should showcase the range of their dramatic abilities. They may be asked to perform the piece more than once.
- All students will also be involved in an improvisation workshop during their allocated block.
- All students must audition in rehearsal blacks.
- Auditions will take place in small groups. Audition times will be emailed to the email address supplied in the online application
- No props or costumes are required.
